Dear Parishioners,

This week we begin the holy season of Lent. The Ash Wednesday Mass schedule will be 6:30 a.m., 8:15 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. The next 40 days are a time to turn to the Lord and renew our spiritual lives. We do this through prayer, fasting, and almsgiving. Please remember that Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fasting (for those of you ages 18 – 59) and abstinence (for those of you 14 and older). We partake of only one full meal on these days and abstain from meat. All other Fridays during Lent are days of abstinence when we do not eat meat. We will have 2 opportunities for Stations of the Cross every Friday during this Lenten season. On the Fridays school is in session, the students will join us at 2:30 p.m. In the evening, we will begin with stations in the Church at 6:30 followed by a (meat-less) pot-luck in the Parish Center. Please bring a dish and the recipe to share. Let us pray for one another during this holy time. Archbishop Lucas dispenses Catholics in the archdiocese from the prohibition of eating meat on St. Patrick's Day this year, so on St. Patrick's Day, Friday, March 17 we can eat meat this year. Those choosing to eat meat on Friday, March 17 are required to abstain from meat on Saturday, March 18.
