PLEASE NOTE the requirements for a person to be eligible to serve as a sponsor.

Archdiocesan policy on sponsors states: One sponsor, male or female, is necessary for Confirmation. Sponsors, sometimes known as godparents, must be:

- Practicing Roman Catholics
- At least 16 years of age
- Confirmed and Communed
- Leading a life of faith which befits the role to be undertaken, for example, if godparents are dating, they must be living chastely and apart, or if they are a married couple, their marriage must have been witnessed in the Catholic Church or must have received proper dispensation.

Sponsors may not be under a canonical penalty, nor may they be either the father or mother of the person to be confirmed. Sponsors must complete their eligibility form with and in the company of their own parish pastor or deacon.
