Please Wear White Today

Pentecost marks the end of the Easter Season and the miraculous gift of the Holy Spirit that constitutes and empowers our Catholic Church. In playful reverence, I ask everyone to take part in the Catholic tradition of Whitsunday – literally “White Sunday,” another name for Pentecost – and to wear as many white clothes as possible today, especially when attending any of our Sabbath Masses on May 18th & 19th.

Babies and catechumens still wear white at their Baptisms, and we employ white attire in the reception of other sacraments, e.g., First Communion, Confirmation, Matrimony, etc. Clergy and liturgical ministers also wear albs – white robes named after the Latin word for white, *albus* – when assisting in the celebration of sacraments. May our white clothing remind us of our Christian dignity and arouse conversations and opportunities to explain our faith to others.
