



#### **Solemnity of the Ascension**


Forty days after rising from the dead on Easter Sunday, Jesus Christ ascended into Heaven to sit at the right hand of His Father. Where He goes, He wishes to lead and take us. This tremendous day is a Holy Day of Obligation for all Catholics; in other words, this occasion is so significant in the life of the Church that it is a mortal sin to deliberately miss Mass on Ascension Thursday or the vigil on the evening before. #### **Confirmation Congratulations!**

Tomorrow on Monday, May 6<sup>th</sup>, during a special Mass at 6 p.m. in St. Philip Neri Church, we continue the longstanding tradition of conferring the gift of the sacrament of Confirmation upon the many youth of our parish and school. Because Archbishop Lucas was unable to come this year and Archbishop Emeritus Curtiss is no longer performing Confirmations, His Excellency has granted me the proper delegation to officiate the sacrament.

What happens tomorrow is a gift of spiritual maturity. The sacrament confers upon the confirmed the sevenfold gifts of the Holy Spirit in a deeper way to equip them to become faithful disciples in the world. Confirmation empowers these young people to evangelize and to live a life of mercy. It is not an end to their spiritual progress at all; rather, it is a new beginning! The Spirit builds upon the existing virtues and charisms of the confirmed and assists them with the deeper spiritual wisdom, fortitude, and piety necessary to remain Catholic Christians in a world often hostile to the Faith.

In advance we congratulate our young disciples. May they know God's love for them in a deeper way and be inspired to use the gifts of the Spirit in evangelization and in the service of others. God bless you *confirmandi* ("those to be confirmed") and your parents and sponsors. Congratulations!

The gospel asks that we "welcome the stranger" among us. Omaha Welcomes the Stranger is a non-profit organization (501c3) that provides temporary shelter and hospitality for migrants and asylum seekers who arrive in Omaha and assists them in finding permanent housing.

At this time, Omaha Welcomes the Stranger (OWS), is assisting a migrant family in need of a vehicle that can accommodate six people—-Dad, Mom, 3 children and new baby on the way. 




