#### From the Pastor

#### **Journey of Faith Anniversary**

Tomorrow, July 1<sup>st</sup>, marks the first anniversary of the partnership between Holy Name and St. Philip Neri-Blessed Sacrament parishes. I know the Archdiocesan pastoral plan brought many changes, but you all maintained patience and generously accepted them. The joint Pastoral Council was formed and will now meet monthly, starting in August. We had growing pains but successfully united our Religious Education programs into one entity while working with both schools. Youth from both parishes will be traveling together for the first time to the Steubenville Conference next weekend, and I see parishioners from both parishes attending Masses and services at the opposite location.

With all the adjustments this year, I apologize that we have not had more occasions for people of both parishes to meet and get to know each other. I aim to do a better job at that next academic year, July 1<sup>st</sup>-June 30<sup>th</sup>, and encourage all of you to do the same. Both parishes have fantastic histories and friendly people. As pastor and spiritual shepherd to both parishes, there is no greater cause of joy than to see the flocks intermingle, unite, and look out for each other. There is no greater pleasure than seeing new friendships emerge, with Jesus and with each other.

#### The Altar Rail: How the Communion Rail Fosters Contemplation and Meditation

This is another article in a series of articles preparing us in Holy Name and St. Philip Neri churches to receive Holy Communion at the Altar Rail, beginning July 20/21, the weekend of the National Eucharistic Congress.

Previously we have seen how the altar rail reflects the mysteries of God. It simultaneously represents the necessary distance we have from our Creator and draws us intimately to the table of that same Lord. One of the other benefits of receiving Communion at the balustrade or altar rail is the time it affords us to prepare for Communion.

Modern Communion lines are efficient, but they may also feel a bit impersonal. The communicant is preoccupied with the line itself. He must attentively walk in stride, carefully inching forward as the line does. All he can see is the back of the head of the person in front of him, and then suddenly he is before the priest or minister. He quickly receives Communion, moves out of the way, and shuffles back to the pew. Our minds are concentrating on so many banal things that we can lose sight of the exquisite reception of Jesus himself.

The altar rail, on the other hand, allows the communicant more time to meditate upon the mystery of the Eucharist. Whether standing or kneeling at the rail, the communicant is stationary. He need not worry about others behind him or in front of him, about bumping into someone or moving too slowly. He simply waits for the priest or minister to bring him Communion or to bestow upon him a prayer of welcome. In that time of calm expectation, the communicant can prepare himself mentally and spiritually for this great gift. After he has received Communion, he might also wait a moment at the rail in thanksgiving and then return to his pew to continue his gratitude to God. There is no rush.

Of course, during the adjustment period, I have no doubt that remembering the new aspects associated with receiving at the rail while be distracting. I assure you, though, that those initial preoccupations will dissolve with time. It will become a steady habit, a habit that will be less distracting and more meditative than receiving Communion on the fly. The individual freedom allowed by reception at the rail will also allow for more deliberate, conscientious, and engaged piety and decisions.




