#### From the Pastor

#### **Seminarian Max Brown**

He is a seminarian of the Archdiocese of Omaha and will continue his discernment of priesthood. Max is an extraordinary young man and I am proud of his desire to hear God's voice. #### From Max Brown

My name is Max Brown, I was born and raised in Omaha, Nebraska. I'm currently a parishioner at St. Philip Neri-Blessed Sacrament Parish, but I consider St. Francis Borgia in Blair, Nebraska, my adopted parish. I grew up as the youngest of three children, and was raised by my parents, Brad and Mary Kay Brown. I enjoy hiking, fishing, and tending to my garden, where I find peace in the outdoors.

I first sensed God's call during my later years at Creighton Prep, a Jesuit high school in Omaha. There, I was blessed with numerous retreats and opportunities to deepen my faith. However, I initially brushed this call aside, choosing to pursue other paths. After high school, I moved to central South Dakota to work for an agronomist. During this time, I was exposed to a high concentration of undiluted Roundup. The effects didn't surface until about a year later, while in college. I then became seriously ill and tried to push through by myself, but after a year and a half, I had to return home to Omaha, where my parents lined up various medical treatments for me.

Through this challenging time, I eventually fell deeply in love with God and experienced a profound conversion back to Catholicism. I'm confident that our Blessed Mother and St. Padre Pio played significant roles in guiding me back to Christ and His Church, and I'm immensely grateful for their intercessions.

About two years ago, I went and talked with the vocation director Fr. Scott Schilmoeller, naively thinking that I would learn about the priesthood and quickly check the box that God wasn't calling me to this vocation. The more I prayed and listened to where God was leading me, I knew I had to give the seminary a chance. This fall, I'll be attending St. Gregory the Great Seminary in Seward, Nebraska, where I'm eager to embrace the fellowship and further discern God's call during the Propaedeutic stage. To anyone discerning the priesthood, I'd offer this advice: lean into your prayer life, frequent the sacraments, and engage fully with your Catholic community.

#### **Safe Environment Training/Recertification**

With our parishes' festivals on the horizon and our schools and other activities beginning even sooner, all adults who will have any contact with children, i.e., adult volunteers for festivals, catechesis, chaperones, coaches, liturgical ministers, etc., must be Safe Environment certified through our archdiocesan process. Our Safe Environment certifications are valid for six years, and it is easy to be recertified online. However, if your 6-year certification has expired for more than 60 days, you will need to retake the in-person class again, so please be attentive to recertifying.

#### **Baptism Classes**

Our Baptism preparation sessions in English and in Spanish are for expectant parents and for parents with unbaptized infants or small children under the age of 7, along with their potential godparents.

- Classes in English normally occur from 2 p.m.-4 p.m., usually on the First Sunday of every month in the Parish Center (basement) of St. Philip Neri Church.
- Classes in Spanish normally occur every other month on a Sunday from 3 p.m.-6 p.m. in the Holy Name Cafeteria.

Participation in one of our preparation classes, either in Spanish or in English, is necessary to schedule a day and time for a Baptism in either HN or SPN churches. Formal registration and participation in the parish is a prerequisite, and pre-registration is further required to attend the class. - The tuition fee is \$50 per child, with a max fee of \$150 per 3 children or more, paid at the time of registration.
- Copies of both birth and baptismal certificates are required for registration.
- Children must be at least 6 years old for their first year
   of First Communion preparation and at least 11 years
   old for the first year of Confirmation preparation.
- <u>Those entering a second year</u> of sacramental preparation <u>are still</u> required to register.
- R.E. classes begin on September 17<sup>th</sup> (A mandatory orientation meeting just for parents with children in R.E. is on September 10<sup>th</sup>).
- All R.E. parent meetings and R.E. classes will take place in St. Philip Neri Catholic School (8202 N. 31st St., Omaha, NE 68112) on Wednesdays, 6:15 p.m.-7:45 p.m.

**Exposition of the Most Blessed Sacrament** is usually Monday through Friday, 5 p.m.-9 p.m. (the final hour being 8-9 p.m.) in the Prayer Chapel. 
