- "Rather, when you hold a banquet, invite the poor, the crippled, the lame, the blind; blessed indeed will you be because of their inability to repay you." How can I reach out more effectively to those on the peripheries? How can I extend hospitality to those in need?

Living the Word this Week How can I make my life a gift for others in charity? Take some time in prayer before the Blessed Sacrament, open your heart to the Lord, and ask him how you might become involved in helping the poor.






