We begin our prayer In the Name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

Meditation Read the Holy Gospel (St. Luke 16:19-31) two or three times and silently reflect. What word(s) in the passage caught your attention, comforted you, or challenged you?

Contemplation Read the Scripture again, followed by this reflection: What conversion of mind, heart, and life is the Lord asking of me?

- "And lying at his door was a poor man named Lazarus." Who is "Lazarus" in my community? How can I give more care and attention to those in need?
- "Moreover, between us and you a great chasm is established." When have I felt separated from God? What are the causes of that separation?
- "They have Moses and the prophets. Let them listen to them." Who can teach me about my faith in a truthful and reliable way? How can I be more attentive to what God is trying to tell me?

Living the Word this Week How can I make my life a gift for others in charity? Consider becoming involved in your parish's outreach to the poor, the homebound, or the unaffiliated.



#### **Priesthood Sunday**

What is this "Priesthood Sunday" that we celebrate today, 28th? Sept. Priesthood Sunday (which is always held on the last Sunday of September and is sponsored by the USA Council of Serra International and the Serra International Foundation) is a special day set aside to honor priesthood in the United States. It is a day to reflect upon and affirm the role of the priesthood in the life of the Church as a central one.
