Lectio Divina for the III Sunday of Easter, April 19: St. Luke 24: 13-35

Reading & Meditation Read the Holy Gospel 2-3 times. Reflect in silence. What words in the Gospel caught my attention, comforted me, or challenged me?

Contemplation Read the Holy Gospel again, followed by this reflection: What conversion of mind, heart, and life is the Lord asking of me?

- “Jesus himself drew near and walked with them, but their eyes were prevented from recognizing him.” What sinful behaviors or attitudes keep me from recognizing Jesus? What graces do I need from God to help me eliminate these behaviors and attitudes?
- “But we were hoping that he would be the one to redeem Israel.” For what do I hope? How can I ground my hopes more fully in God?
- “Were not our hearts burning within us while he spoke to us on the way and opened the Scriptures to us?” What parts of my faith am I most passionate about? How can I love God even more?

Closing Prayer After silent reflection, pray the Our Father and Psalm 16.

Living the Word this Week How can I make my life a gift for others in charity? Spend some time in prayer before the Blessed Sacrament expressing your love for God and giving thanks for his love for you.

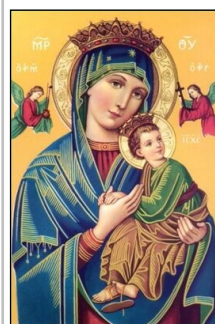

New Lighting and Bell Chimes in SPN Church

This month, we replaced the burned-out lights in the St. Philip Neri Church nave with brighter, cost-efficient LED lighting. It is possible to use different bulbs with a warmer, slightly softer light; the cost for new softer, warmer bulbs is very low. ***Please let us know your preference.***

Our new bell chimes are now ringing! The bells are scheduled to ring 5 minutes before the 10 a.m. Sunday Mass and the 8:15 a.m. Masses on Tuesday and Friday. They also chime at the top of the hour from 8 a.m. to 8 p.m. There are also special bells or chimes for special occasions and holy days. ***Please give us your feedback on the lights and bell chimes.*** Thank you again to our many generous benefactors for these church improvements.

Baptism Classes

Our Baptism preparation sessions in English and in Spanish are for expectant parents and for parents with unbaptized infants or small children under the age of 7, along with their potential godparents.

- **Classes in English** normally occur from 2 p.m.-4 p.m. on the First Sunday of every month in the Parish Center (basement) of St. Philip Neri Church. Next class: May 3rd.
- **Classes in Spanish** normally occur every other month on a Sunday from 3 p.m.-6 p.m. in the Holy Name Cafeteria. The next class is on April 19.

Participation in one of our preparation classes, either in Spanish or in English, is necessary to schedule a day and time for a Baptism in either HN or SPN churches. Formal registration and participation in the parish is a prerequisite, and **pre-registration is further required to attend the class.** Please contact the secretary of your respective parish, Holy Name or St. Philip Neri-Blessed Sacrament, to pre-register.

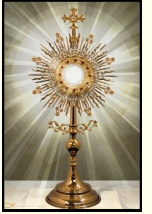

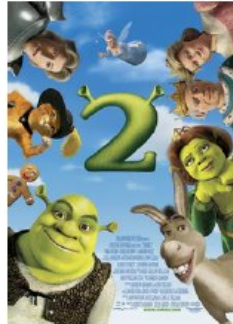
