St. Matthew 28:16-20

Reading & Meditation Read the Holy Gospel 2-3 times. Reflect in silence. What words in the Gospel caught my attention, comforted me, or challenged me?

Contemplation Read the Holy Gospel again, followed by this reflection:

What conversion of mind, heart, and life is the Lord asking of me?

- “When they saw him, they worshiped, but they doubted.” When have my doubts kept me from living my faith fully? How can I offer support and encouragement to people who may be experiencing doubt?
- “Teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you.” Who has been the most influential guide in my faith? What resources do I have to learn more about my faith?
- “And behold, I am with you always, until the end of the age.” How do I experience God’s enduring presence in my life? How can I reach out to those who feel abandoned and alone?

Closing Prayer After silent reflection, pray the Our Father and Psalm 47.

Living the Word this Week How can I make my life a gift for others in charity?

entrance procession of the Mass as they strew flower petals - little bags with flower petals will be provided.

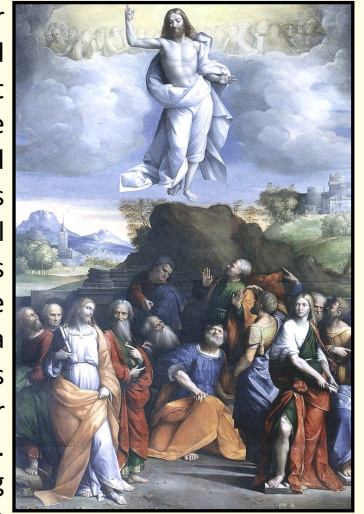

On the fortieth day after Easter Sunday, Jesus Christ ascended into Heaven to sit at the right hand of His Father. Where He goes, He wishes to lead and take us. This tremendous day is a Holy Day of Obligation for all Catholics; in other words, this occasion is so significant in the life of the Church that it is a mortal sin to deliberately miss Mass on Ascension Thursday or the vigil on the evening before. 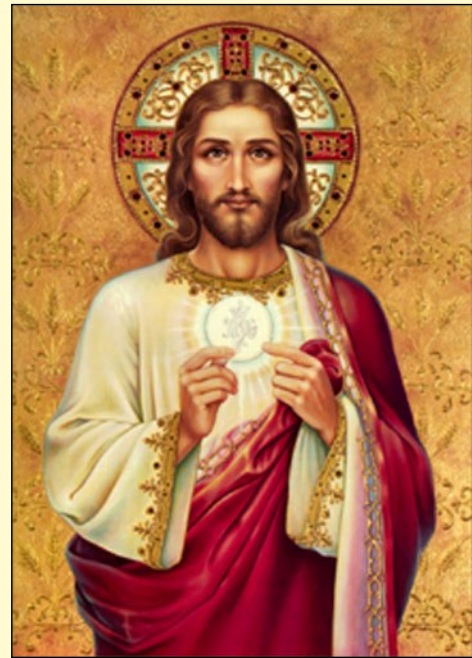

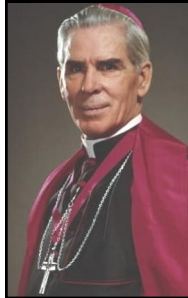
