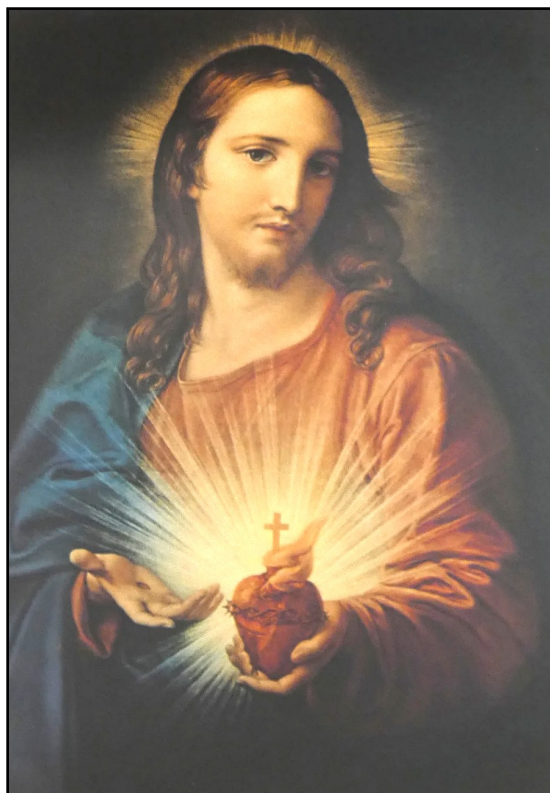

What conversion of mind, heart, and life is the Lord asking of me?

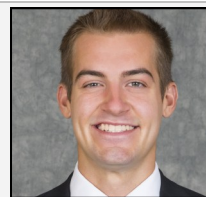
- *“The harvest is abundant but the laborers are few.”*

Summer Missionary Appeal

Every summer every parish participates in the Missionary Appeal, a chance to assist in missionary efforts throughout the world or in underserved places in our own country. Usually, a member of the clergy or consecrated life visit the parish to explain their missionary activity. This summer, Archbishop McGovern himself will celebrate and preach at all our Sabbath Masses next weekend, June 20/21. Additionally, he is bringing Father Sanja from Mongolia.

Our participation in this year's Missionary Appeal will benefit the Apostolic Prefecture of Ulaanbaatar, a missionary jurisdiction that covers the entire country of Mongolia. The local bishop, Bishop Giorgio Marengo, was created a Cardinal by Pope Francis in 2022. Pope Francis then visited Mongolia in 2023. The prefecture is not yet a diocese, having only 14,000 Catholics in the area. Missionaries come from Italy, Korea and the Philippines to share our Catholic faith. Please be generous and help share our Faith with the Mongolian peoples.
