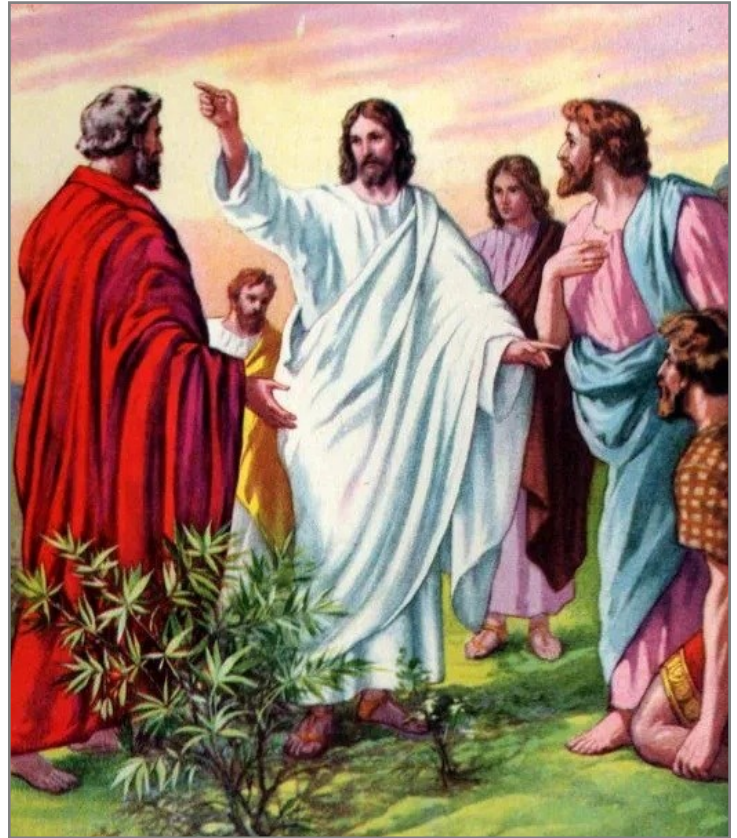

The Twelfth Sunday in Ordinary Time ~ June 21, 2026

Jeremiah 20:10-13 Psalm 69 Romans 5:12-15 St. Matthew 10:26-33

Reading: Read the Holy Gospel 2-3 times. **Meditation:** Reflect in silence. What words in the Gospel caught my attention, comforted, or challenged me? **Prayer:** Bring to the Lord the praise, petition, or thanksgiving the Word inspires in you.

Contemplation *Read the Holy Gospel again, followed by this reflection:*

What conversion of mind, heart, and life is the Lord asking of me?

- *“Nothing is concealed that will not be revealed, nor secret that will not be known.”* When have I felt burdened by my secrets? How can I share myself more honestly and with others?
- *“What I say to you in the darkness, speak in the light; what you hear whispered, proclaim on the housetops.”* Do I whisper my faith or proclaim it with love? How can I share God’s message of love and peace more faithfully?
- *“Even all the hairs of your head are counted.”* How have I experienced God’s loving care recently? How attentive am I to others and to their needs?

Closing Prayer *After silent reflection, pray the Our Father and Psalm 69.*

Living the Word this Week *How can I make my life a gift for others in charity?* Share your faith by taking some action that supports the dignity of all human beings: write to a legislator, feed the homeless, support women in crisis pregnancies, etc. <https://catholic.bible/lectio-divina-in-english/>

This summer, Archbishop McGovern himself is celebrating and preaching at all our Sabbath Masses TODAY, June 20/21. Additionally, he is bringing Father Sanja from Mongolia. I know you will make both feel very welcome.



Our participation in this year's Missionary Appeal will benefit the Apostolic Prefecture of Ulaanbaatar, a missionary jurisdiction that covers the entire country of Mongolia. The local bishop, Bishop Giorgio Marengo, was created a cardinal by Pope Francis in 2022. Pope Francis then visited Mongolia in 2023. The prefecture is not yet a diocese, having only 14,000 Catholics in the area. Missionaries come from Italy, Korea and the Philippines to share our Catholic faith. Please be generous and help share our Faith with the Mongolian peoples.
