2 Kings 4:8-11,14-16 Psalm 89 Romans 6:3-4,8-11 St. Matthew 10:37-42

Reading: Read the Holy Gospel 2-3 times. **Meditation:** Reflect in silence. What words in the Gospel caught my attention, comforted, or challenged me? **Prayer:** Bring to the Lord the praise, petition, or thanksgiving the Word inspires in you.

Contemplation *Read the Holy Gospel again, followed by this reflection:*

What conversion of mind, heart, and life is the Lord asking of me?

- “Whoever does not take up his cross and follow after me is not worthy of me.” What crosses am I bearing now? Are there others whose crosses I can help to carry?
- “Whoever finds his life will lose it, and whoever loses his life for my sake will find it.” How can I learn to give more of myself in love and faith? What do I truly value in my life?
- “And whoever gives only a cup of cold water to one of these little ones to drink... will surely not lose his reward.” Who needs my loving care? What practical assistance can I offer to those in need?

Our country is turning 250! Celebrate her birthday (and help blow out a lot of candles) with a special Mass in English at 9:00 a.m. on Saturday, July 4th, in St. Philip Neri Church. As a result of the national holiday, both parish offices are closed on Friday, July 3rd, though the 8:15 a.m. Mass on July 3rd in St. Philip Neri Church will carry on as usual.



Holy Name Parking Lot

The minor repairs to the Holy Name parking lot are completed. Again, these were only stopgap, affordable repairs that will afford us the time to raise the hundreds of thousands necessary to replace the entire campus parking lot in 2-3 years. Thanks to you and all our generous donors.

Holy Name Sign

While the current sign in front of Holy Name Church is sturdy, a new sign could better explain our presence. Firstly, the current sign only says Holy Name Church. It doesn't mention that we are a Catholic Church. Second, it doesn't list our Mass times, nor does it reveal our bilingual nature and services. We are going to start looking into a possible new sign that will attract more people and better communicate our mission. Such a seemingly simple task like erecting a new sign takes research and often encounters hurdles and limitations due to zoning laws. If you are interested in donating toward a new sign, please contact me, Fr. Cook, or our Business Manager, Ted Snoddy. We may have the potential to install a versatile, digital sign or at least a sign with changeable lettering. Please pray for this endeavor and all involved.

Baptism Classes

Our Baptism preparation sessions in English and in Spanish are for expectant parents and for parents with unbaptized infants or small children under the age of 7, along with their potential godparents.

- **Classes in English** normally are on the First Sunday of each month from 2 p.m.-4 p.m. in the Parish Center (basement) of St. Philip Neri Church. The next class is July 5th.
- **Classes in Spanish** normally are every other month on a Sunday from 3 p.m.-6 p.m. in the Holy Name Cafeteria. The next class is August 16th.

Participation in one of our preparation classes, either in Spanish or in English, is necessary to schedule a day and time for a Baptism in either HN or SPN churches. Formal registration and participation in the parish is a prerequisite, and **pre-registration is further required to attend the class.** Please contact the secretary of your respective parish, Holy Name or St. Philip Neri-Blessed Sacrament, to pre-register.
