Lectio Divina: The Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity, 31 May 2026

Exodus 34:4b-6,8-9; Daniel 3:52-56; 2 Corinthians 13:11-13; St. John 3:16-18

Reading & Meditation Read the Holy Gospel 2-3 times. Reflect in silence. What words in the Gospel caught my attention, comforted me, or challenged me?

Contemplation Read the Holy Gospel again, followed by this reflection:

What conversion of mind, heart, and life is the Lord asking of me?

- “God so loved the world that he gave his only Son.” When have I felt God’s love most intensely? How can I emulate Jesus’ self-giving love?
- “For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world.” When have I judged others? When have I been subject to others’ judgment and prejudice?
- “Whoever believes in him will not be condemned.” When has my faith supported me in a time of trial or difficulty? How would the way I live change if I set my heart on heaven?

Closing Prayer After silent reflection, pray the Our Father and Daniel 3.

Living the Word this Week How can I make my life a gift for others in charity? Pray for a respect for the dignity of all human life, including the unborn, persons with disabilities, those who are dying, and those on death row. <https://catholic.bible/lectio-divina-in-english/>

Solemnity of the Trinity

Today, nestled between the solemnities of Pentecost and Corpus Christi, is a celebration of the heart of our Faith: The Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity. The Trinity is composed of three distinct Divine Persons Who are all equally one God. Three in one, one in three? The Trinity certainly defies our experience of physics, but God, Who created physics, is beyond physics.

The Trinity is a true mystery but one we can intuitively understand through a participation in love. Like the Trinity Itself, love unites separate persons into a shared oneness. If God is love, and we are made in His image, then we are created for relationship: We are made to be loved and to love.



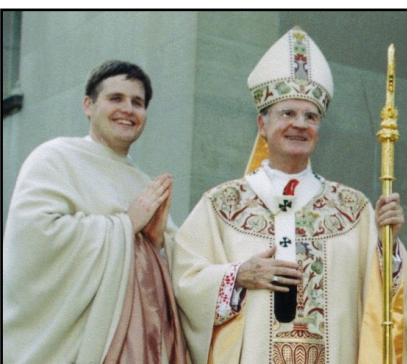
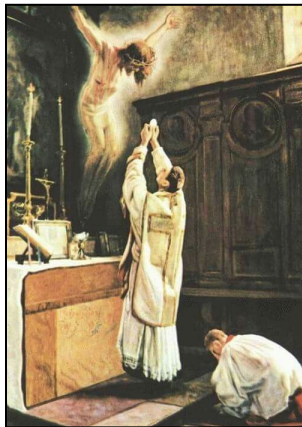

It is also our process for any already baptized, Catholic adults (16 years of age and older) who are still in need of receiving the Sacraments of Confirmation, Reconciliation, and/or First Communion. Baptism Classes

Our Baptism preparation sessions in English and in Spanish are for expectant parents and for parents with unbaptized infants or small children under the age of 7, along with their potential godparents.

- **Classes in English** normally occur from 2 p.m.-4 p.m. on the First Sunday of each month in the Parish Center (basement) of St. Philip Neri Church. Next class is June 7.
- **Classes in Spanish** normally occur every other month on a Sunday from 3 p.m.-6 p.m. in the Holy Name Cafeteria. The next class is June 19.

Participation in one of our preparation classes, either in Spanish or in English, is necessary to schedule a day and time for a Baptism in either HN or SPN churches. Formal registration and participation in the parish is a prerequisite, and **pre-registration is further required to attend the class**. Please contact the secretary of your respective parish, Holy Name or St. Philip Neri-Blessed Sacrament, to pre-register.
