The Eighteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time ~ August 2, 2026

Isaiah 55:1-3 Psalm 145 Romans 8:35,37-39 St. Matthew 14:13-21

Begin by praying the Collect from today's Mass or a prayer to the Holy Spirit.

Reading: Read the Holy Gospel two or three times.

Meditation: Reflect in silence. What words in the Gospel caught my attention, comforted me, or challenged me?

Prayer: Read the Holy Gospel one more time. Bring to the Lord the praise, petition, or thanksgiving that the Word inspires in you.

Contemplation: *Read the Holy Gospel again, followed by this reflection:*

What conversion of mind, heart, and life is the Lord asking of me?

- *His heart was moved with pity for them.* When have I found it difficult to accept help and compassion? Who needs my compassion and care?
- *Give them some food yourselves.* For what do I hunger? How can I meet the physical needs of those in my community?
- *Bring them here to me.* Who can I invite to Mass or to another church event? How can I place my gifts at the service of Christ and his Church?

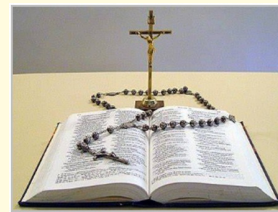
Closing Prayer: *After silent reflection, pray the Our Father and Psalm 145.*

Living the Word this Week: *How can I make my life a gift for others in charity?*

Discern participation in parish or archdiocesan efforts to assist those suffering from physical or spiritual hunger. <https://catholic.bible>

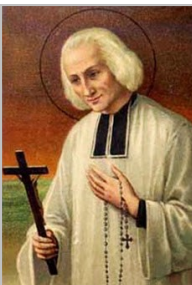

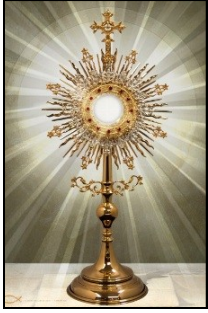

Baptism Classes

Maintenance Needs

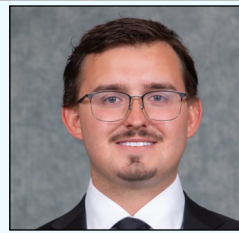
