What conversion of mind, heart, and life is the Lord asking of me?

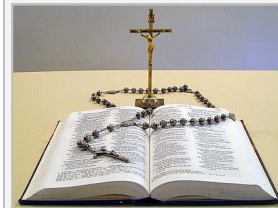

From Our Pastor Father Cook



Business Manager & Maintenance Needs

After an interim period, Ted Snoddy is now the permanent Business Manager for both Holy Name and St. Philip Neri-Blessed Sacrament. He can handle both duties well, so please reach out to him with any financial or tithing questions. Moreover, if you encounter maintenance issues at either campus, please contact Ted, preferably by email, and let him know about them, or you may speak with the respective Maintenance Supervisor at either location, José Alberto Alcantar (HN) or Eric Brink (SPN-BS). Ted will be working with the supervisors to coordinate repairs, bids, and guidance. You see more than the staff does, so please let us know how we can beautify, secure, and improve our campus. Please keep in mind that we do not have limitless budgets, so we will always do what we can when we can.

Saturday Mass Music

Chris Mitchell is a son of HN Church and HN School and, out of his stewardship, he has volunteered for many years as the Director to the HN Choir in English. He has musical and education degrees and a great knowledge of Holy Name and her traditions. Aside from his own considerable talents as a cantor and organist, Chris has done an outstanding job elevating our sacred music, forming our choir, and helping to unite both parishes and peoples in English and Spanish. Chris and his wife, Christine, are moving in a week and we wish them the very best and offer our sincere thanks for such remarkable leadership and generosity. We will miss you.

I have been actively looking for a replacement to formally direct our HN Choir in English at the Saturday 5 p.m. Mass, but, so far, I have not found anyone available or with suitable education and knowledge in the field. As a result, the music in the 5 p.m. Mass on Saturdays will change a little bit to make it more manageable:

- Nate Mitchell, Chris' brother, will help with some organ accompaniment, when possible. Many of the Mass prayers and hymns may no longer be able to be accompanied by instruments; instead, they will sometimes be sung *a cappella*.
- The Responsorial Psalm will no longer be chanted by a cantor or the choir. Instead, the lector will read the entire psalm.
- We may not utilize the Entrance Antiphon (Introit) or Communion Antiphon as much or at all.
- All hymns will come from an established repertoire of music already known well by the choir and that will be democratically chosen by the choir members.
- The Mass prayers will be sung to a simpler setting, the chant found in the Roman Missal itself.
- The choir will continue to rehearse in the cafeteria an hour before the 5 p.m. Mass.

I am grateful to our HN Choir in English and its musical accompanists for their patience and generosity in this transition and for their incredible dedication over the years. We are blessed by your kindness and talents.

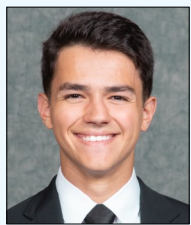

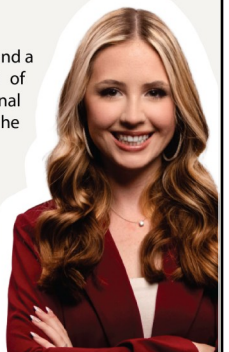
