The Twentieth Sunday in Ordinary Time ~ August 16, 2026

Isaiah 56:1,6-7 Psalm 67 Romans 11:13-15,2-32 St. Matthew 15:21-28

Begin by praying the Collect from today's Mass or a prayer to the Holy Spirit.

Reading: Read the Holy Gospel two or three times. **Meditation:** Reflect in silence. What words in the Gospel caught my attention, comforted me, or challenged me? **Prayer:** Read the Holy Gospel one more time. Bring to the Lord the praise, petition, or thanksgiving that the Word inspires in you.

Contemplation: *Read the Holy Gospel again, followed by this reflection:*

What conversion of mind, heart, and life is the Lord asking of me?

- "But Jesus did not say a word in answer to her." When have I felt that my prayers are going unanswered? How can I persevere in these dry times?
- "I was sent only to the lost sheep of the house of Israel." Who are the "lost sheep" in my community? How can I reach out to those on the peripheries?
- "O woman, great is your faith! Let it be done for you as you wish." Whose faith inspires me? How can my life of faith be an example to others?

Closing Prayer: *After silent reflection, pray the Our Father and Psalm 67.*

Living the Word this Week: *How can I make my life a gift for others in charity?*

Discern how you might assist parish/diocesan efforts to help those in need. Persevere in prayer by praying a novena (9 days) for a special intention, trusting that the Lord hears our prayers. (ewtn.com/catholicism/devotions/novenas-75)

Safe Environment Certification

With our parish festivals on the horizon and our schools and other activities beginning, all adults who will have any contact with children or vulnerable adults, i.e., adult volunteers for festivals, catechesis, coaches, chaperones, liturgical ministers, ushers, funeral luncheons, etc., must be Safe Environment certified through our archdiocesan process. If you have not attended Safe Environment training in the past, the first step is to create a new account. Read and acknowledge the Archdiocesan Code of Conduct, sign up for a training session, and submit a background check. There are many training dates and locations.

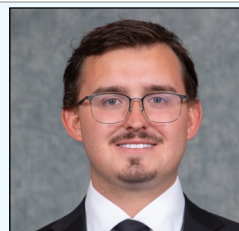

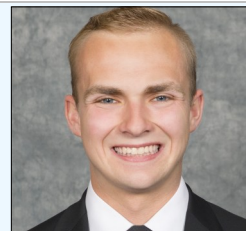

Baptism Classes

Our Baptism preparation sessions in English and in Spanish are for expectant parents and for parents with unbaptized infants or small children under the age of 7, along with their potential godparents.

- **Classes in English** are usually the First Sunday of each month from 2 p.m. to 4 p.m. in the Parish Center (basement) of St. Philip Neri Church. Next class is Sept. 6.
- **Classes in Spanish** normally are every other month on a Sunday from 3 p.m. to 6 p.m. in the Holy Name Cafeteria. The next class is on August 16.

Participation in one of our preparation classes, either in Spanish or in English, is necessary to schedule a day and time for a Baptism in either HN or SPN churches. Formal registration and participation in the parish is a prerequisite, and **pre-registration is required to attend the class**. Please contact the secretary of your respective parish, Holy Name or St. Philip Neri-Blessed Sacrament, to pre-register.

Becoming Catholic for Youth & Adults

Becoming Catholic (R.C.I.A. or O.C.I.A.) is our process for anyone 8 years and older desiring to receive Baptism as a Catholic.
