Twenty-first Sunday in Ordinary Time ~ August 23, 2026 ~ St. Matthew 16:13-20

Pray the *Collect* of today's Mass or a prayer to the Holy Spirit. **Read** the Gospel two or three times. **Reflect** in silence. What words in the Gospel caught my attention, comforted me, or challenged me? **Prayer:** Read the Gospel again. Bring to the Lord the praise, petition, or thanksgiving the Word inspires in you.

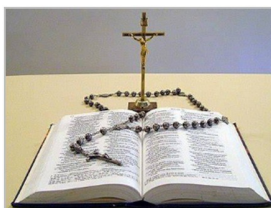
Contemplation: *Read the Holy Gospel again, followed by this reflection:*

What conversion of mind, heart, and life is the Lord asking of me?

- "Who do people say that the Son of Man is?" How would I describe Jesus to someone who does not yet know him? How has my image of Jesus changed over the course of my life?
- "For flesh and blood has not revealed this to you, but my heavenly Father." Who have been reliable teachers about my faith? How can I discern the reliability of the information that I receive about my faith?
- "Upon this rock I will build my church." On what foundations does my faith rest? How can I help to build the Church's mission?

Closing Prayer: *After silent reflection, pray the Our Father and Psalm 138.*

Living the Word this Week: *How can I make my life a gift for others in charity? Share your faith and love of Christ with one person this week. (catholic.bible)*



Safe Environment Certification

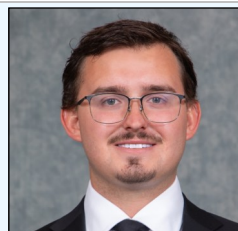

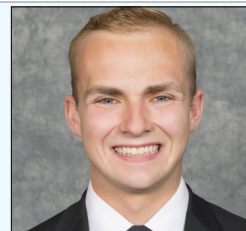

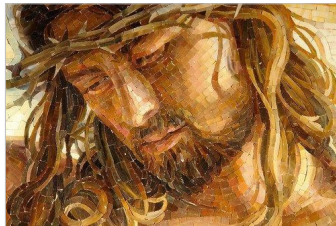
